Re: Summer Projects

Dear Steve,

I apologize for not getting this to you sooner, but here you go. As I mentioned on the phone, much of what we would like to do this summer centers on the new Millicent Chalet. Demolition is scheduled to begin the first week in May. All of the debris will be removed from the canyon and has already been tested for harmful substances. I don't think any further work needs to be done in this regard. However, I am sure you have complete plans now and hope you will let us know if you need anything else to move the process forward.

Outside of the Chalet we would still like to address a few things on the mountain this summer. They are listed below with a brief description of the project.

Majestic Millicent Connection:

This intersection continues to cause problems at the resort. As you may remember we have done some work in this area in the past under a previous authorization. At that time we left about 6 trees that we hoped would not block visibility in this intersection. Unfortunately better visibility is still needed and we need to remove the trees.

Mountain Bike Trail:

Though I doubt we complete the entire project this season we would like to start taking on sections of it when we have equipment available.

Thunder Road Snowmaking extension:

Snowmaking is currently terminated at the top of the Thunder Road ski run. We would like to extend a line down the run to a drainage channel in order to make snow in this area and drain the system. Total length of the extension is approximately 300'. We would also be replacing the existing night lighting wire in this location.
