

→ 3. Lift Installations

- Install the Sacajawea Connect Lift—a new lift from below the *Powder Reserve Traverse* to the top terminal of the Sacajawea Lift
- Install the new Peaked Lift (previously-approved)
- Install a lift on Lightning Ridge, in the southern portion of the SUP area (previously-approved)
- Install the Wishing Well Lift below Targhee Village (private and NFS lands)
- Install two additional teaching carpets at the base area

→ 4. Snowmaking

- Install snowmaking infrastructure sufficient to provide approximately 58 acres of coverage (existing + planned)

5. Guest Services

- A 4,500 to 5,800 square foot on-mountain restaurant on Fred's Mountain, near the top terminal of the Dreamcatcher Lift
- A 5,200 to 6,600 square foot restaurant near the top terminal of the Sacajawea Lift
- Warming cabins in Ricks Basin (to support Grand Targhee's Nordic system) and at the top of the planned Lightning Lift
- A restroom and warming facility with limited food service at the bottom terminal of the previously approved Blackfoot Lift

6. Multi-Season Recreation Trails

A total of 28 miles of multi-season trails (hiking, biking, equestrian) will be constructed, bringing Grand Targhee's total multiple use trail network to approximately 51.7 miles.

7. Snowtubing

- Construct a dedicated, permanent tubing and snowplay facility at Targhee Village (on NFS lands)

8. Resort Operations

- Construct and reclaim roads throughout Grand Targhee's SUP area
- Relocate the maintenance/snowcat storage facility (10,000 square feet) and avalanche control explosives magazine to NFS lands
