

APPENDIX B - LAND TRADE

1.1. CONVEYANCE OF NON-FEDERAL LANDS TO THE UNITED STATES

The following lands were proposed for exchange to the United states:

- All of Section 19, located in Township 21 North, Range 20 East Willamette Meridian, Chelan Co. Washington.
- The NE ¼ of Section 30, located in Township 21 North, Range 20 East Willamette Meridian, Chelan Co. Washington, Except, that portion owned by the Stemilt Irrigation District.

All totaling approximately 779 acres, more or less.

1.2. CONVEYANCE OF FEDERAL LANDS TO MISSION RIDGE MOUNTAIN CORPORATION

The following lands were proposed for conveyance to Mission Ridge.

- All of Section 24, located in Township 22 North, Range 20 East Willamette Meridian, Chelan Co. Washington.
- Other equalization parcels owned by the Federal Government as may be required to balance value.

This land exchange was intended to put all Mission Ridge Ski Area slope lands under US Forest Service Administration, and acquire more valuable elk habitat elsewhere for the Washington State Department of Wildlife. Mission Ridge would have acquired Section 24, which includes the Base Area.

As this analysis proceeded, the land exchange between New Mission LLC and the State became more uncertain. The proponents have dropped the land exchange from the proposed action, and it is not a foreseeable action. Therefore the exchange is a specific alternative that was considered but eliminated from detailed study.
