We had another amazing winter and can't wait for the upcoming season to begin. Sierra Summit is committed to providing you with the best quality skiing and riding experience in Central California. We've added two new chairlifts in the past two years along with several newly developed runs and more indoor seating and food services with the construction of the Mainstream Station Day Lodge. Plans are underway NOW for even more improvements this summer that are sure to increase the level of service and enhance our winter guest experience.

Summer improvements include additional parking with easier drive through access in and out. The Mainstream Station expansion will add another 2500 square feet of indoor seating and food services. In addition, our rental and repair shops are undergoing a remodel to service our guests more efficiently.

On the mountain, two new snowcats will be added to our fleet to ensure more consistent grooming on our runs and in our popular terrain parks. For you to enjoy first tracks, we will be opening the lifts earlier on weekends and holidays and we are installing a new loading area at Chair One with a moving carpet that will allow easier access to the chairs and increase lift efficiency.

To ensure an early season opening and provide more consistent snow coverage, we are increasing our snowmaking pond's water capacity by a million gallons. We are also increasing our pumping capacity and adding more snow guns. In addition, we will be starting the first phase of snowmaking capabilities to the Westridge



Most exciting is the addition of a new and much-needed learning area. This gentle beginner slope will be serviced by an easy-to-ride moving carpet designed for beginners. The new learning area will also have snowmaking capabilities and will most certainly enhance the first time learning experience for skiers and riders of all ages.

Plans are underway for an exciting winter full of activities and events. We hope you will share in our enthusiasm for the coming season and that we'll be seeing a lot of you this winter!
