PROJECT DESCRIPTION :

Install 3000' of 8" steel air and 8" steel water line. Will involve drilling and blasting of approximately 2500' of rock. Trenching will be excavated by 225 Cat. Pipe will be bedded in clean backfill and compacted to 90% compaction. Area impacted will be returned to it's original state and erosion control measures will be implemented upon completion. Note that the area to be impacted has previously been graded and is primarily hard rock with very little erodible soils.

PROJECT NAME : Beginner Lift Snowmaking

PROJECT DESCRIPTION :

Install approximately 1000' of 6" air and 6" water line within the beginner lift trail system. Hydrants to be installed at 100' intervals. Trenching to be excavated by track type excavator. Backfill to be compacted to 90% with excess material to be hauled away or spread about. Finish grading to take place during slope grading work. Some blasting will be required.
