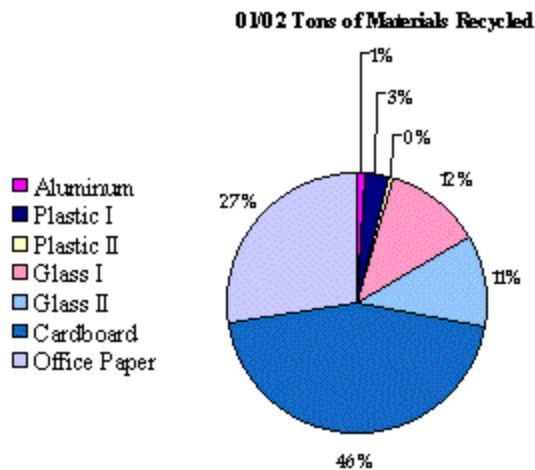
RECYCLING AT SUGAR BOWL

Sugar Bowl implemented an office paper, cardboard & beverage container recycling program in the fall of 2001. Recyclables were separated on-site and redeemed at the Eastern Regional Landfill Recycling Center.



The following materials were recycled during the first season of implementation:
